Depending on workflow configuration, you may be required to [confirm your identity](#) by providing either your password or your username and password, prior to taking part in a [content review](#).

The Approve and Reject buttons are disabled until you enter the requested credentials.

On entering the username and password, the buttons will become active. The reviewer can then mouse-over each review button to display the destination state.
