## Edit the workflow using workflow builder

You can use workflow builder to:

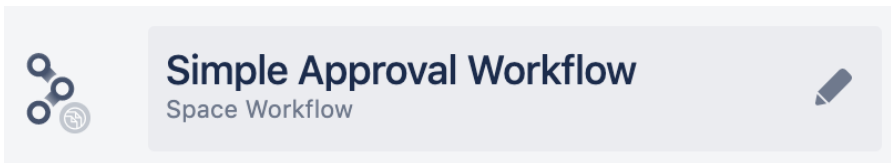
- edit the workflow name and description.
- disable/enable [read confirmation for the final state](#).
- add parameters and their values.
- add [workflow triggers](#) using markup. (These are logged as **Rules** in workflow builder).
- configure the display of the progress tracker bar in the workflow popup.
- add a content label filter to control the application of a space workflow to specific content.
- set the type of content to add and apply the workflow (pages, blog posts or both).

## Workflow editor

Choose the workflow name in the [workflow panel](#) to edit the workflow (or select the **Workflow** lozenge in the Navigator panel).



Use the workflow editor to amend/add the

- workflow name (required)
- workflow description (optional)
- the label filter for the application of the workflow based on the content labels (optional)

Simple Approval Workflow

Description

A Simple Approval Workflow, a page's state can be for 'Review', 'Approved' or 'Rejected'. Only 'Approved' pages are visible to Read-only users.

Invert labels

Filter the content on which the workflow should be applied based on its labels.

The **Advanced** menu allows you to further configure the workflow.

- use **Sticky labels** to set one or more labels that only admin users can remove from the page

Sticky Labels

Only the admins will be able to remove them from the content.

- set the type of content the workflow will be applied to (pages, blog posts or both)

### Content Types

Blog Posts

Which types of content should the workflow be applied to

A workflow is added and applied by default to both pages and blog posts.

Note that workflow builder will not allow both these checkboxes to be unchecked at the same time. If only one content type option is checked and you wish to change the content type the workflow is applied to, simply check the desired content type before unchecking the one that is not required.

- enabling/disabling the display of the progress tracker in the workflow popup on the content

## Options

- Display Progress Tracker
- Update `{status}` macro when the workflow state changes

You can also check **Update `{status}` macro** to allow the workflow to update the Comala Page Status macro (if added to the page).

## Add a trigger to a workflow using workflow editor

The **Advanced** menu also allows you to add the markup for triggers.

Any [triggers](#) added to a workflow are displayed as **Rules** for the workflow.



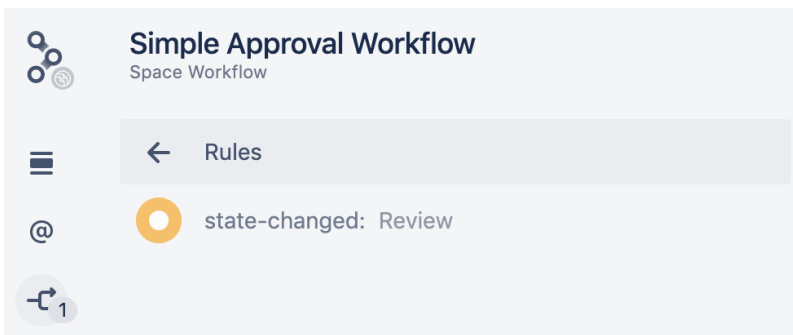
### Simple Approval Workflow

Space Workflow

A Simple Approval Workflow, a page's state can be for 'Review', 'Approved' or 'Rejected'. Only 'Approved' pages are visible to Read-only users.

Workflow builder will display the context of each **Rule** added.



**Rules** can only be amended by editing the [trigger markup](#).

The workflow [states can be edited](#) by choosing an individual state in the [workflow panel](#).
