Overview

The **{pagestatus}** macro displays the current workflow state name in a lozenge.

For example:



The page status will only be displayed in the page if the viewing user already has permission to see workflow status information.

Where to use it?

Optional.

One or more **{pagestatus}** macros can be used in a page or blog post.

It can also be used in macros which render content in the context of pages and blog posts:

- [add-comment macro](#) — Comment on a page or blog post
- [increment-metadata macro](#) — Increment a metadata value to support custom versions (available from v6.11+)
- [pagefooter macro](#) — Add content to page footer
- [pageheader macro](#) — Add content to page header
- [send-email macro](#) — Send an email
- [set-message macro](#) — Add/remove a page message
- [workflow macro](#) — Defines a workflow template
