## Deprecated

## Overview

The `{comment}` macro is used to annotate the workflow template to explain rationale and other useful information.

The comments are only visible while editing the template in the markup editor. They will not be seen by end-users.

## Where to use it?

Optional.

One or more `{comment}` macros can be put in a `{workflow}` macro.
