

Parameter References

Overview

Workflow parameters, defined by the `{workflowparameter}` macro, can be referenced by their name wrapped in @ (at) symbols.

Where can they be used?

You can use parameter references in the following situations:

- Any macro parameter (including macro bodies, where applicable) which supports [Value References](#)
- [Conditions](#), including custom value reference conditions
- [Triggers](#) and [Actions](#), which are initiated by [Events](#)

Example

In the example below, a parameter called "The Message" is referenced as "@The Message@" in the body of the `{set-message}` macro which is triggered by transitioning to the `stop` state.

  {workflowparameter:The Message}
    Default value for "The Message"
  {workflowparameter}
  {state:Start}
  {state}
  {state:Stop}
  {state}
  {trigger:statechanged|state=Stop}
    {set-message}@The Message@{set-message}
  {trigger}
{workflow}
```
